Final Exams will take place from Wednesday, June 15th – Monday June 27th. This includes Diploma and PAT Exams. (*Part A of the English 30 and Social Studies 30 Diploma Exams will take place on June 13th and 14th*.)

Students are not required to be at school during these dates unless they have an exam. Students may make arrangements with teachers for exam help during this time, but are advised not to just show up for help without making prior arrangements, as teachers will be supervising other exams and may not be available.

The last day of regular classes will be TUESDAY, June 14th.

SCHOOL FEES ARE NOW OVERDUE.


Statements have been sent home and any School, Text Book, Option Class or other fees should be cleared up via SchoolCash Online <u>immediately.</u>

KAHS June 2022 Final Exam RULES

The LAST DAY of Semester 2 classes is <u>Tuesday</u>, January 14, 2022.

Students who are scheduled to write **English 30-1**, **Part A DIPLOMA EXAMS on June 13th** and <u>Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2</u>, **Part A on June 14th** will be excused from all classes on that day. However, they are welcome to attend afternoon classes if they are finished their exams.

ALL students scheduled to write a final exam MUST be present at the scheduled time unless prior arrangements have been made with the teacher. A student who misses an exam due to illness MUST report the illness to the teacher immediately, <u>AND</u> produce written verification from his/her doctor, in the case of a Diploma exam.

<u>Students should be in place for their exams 15 minutes prior to the exam start time.</u> Diploma exam students may NOT leave the exam room until 1 hour after the exam start time.

STUDENTS ARRIVING ONE HOUR AFTER THE EXAM START TIME, WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO WRITE THE EXAM.

Students who require exam accommodations will write exams in the Computer Lab.

Textbook returns will be possible between 8:30 and 9:00 on each final exam day from June 15th June 27th. Students should deliver *their own textbooks* to the *BOOKROOM* immediately prior to writing the subject exam the text was used for.
