EDSBY/SCHOOL MESSENGER

The Palliser School Division has moved to a different Student Information System called **Edsembli**. This means that **PowerSchool is no longer being used across The Palliser School Division**.

School Messenger is currently not working across The Palliser School Division for parents to report attendance, or for schools to report to parents (phone and email) with daily attendance updates.

The new Parent/Student Portal connected to Edsembli is called Edsby. Through Edsby, parents can view grades and attendance and also report attendance directly to the school office. The KA office has been working to get this system ready, and we believe it will be available for parents and students to start using in the first week in October. When it is available parents will receive an email invitation to sign up for an Edsby account. There is also an Edsby App available for download on all platforms.

Those that have not returned the Demographic Verification forms to the office (these were sent home with students on Registration Day), may experience delays in getting this up and running, as we have not been able to verify their contact information. Please return these forms as soon as possible.

Until this system is up and running smoothly, please call our office at 403-345-3383 to report any student attendance.

We appreciate your patience as we also learn this new system and work through the issues that this change-over has caused.

Information Verification/FOIPP/ Technology Consent Forms

In September, Grade 10 – 12 students were given a package which included a *WHITE* Information Verification Form, an *ORANGE coloured* Information Technology User Agreement/Permission Form and a *BRIGHT YELLOW coloured* Consents for Information Disclosure form. While most of these forms have been returned to the office, there are still some missing. If you still have these forms please complete them (must be completed by a parent/guardian) and return them to the office immediately. If you have lost your forms, please come to the office to get new ones.

These forms are important and must be completed each year and submitted to the office.

Most Grade 9 students completed these forms when they registered for KAHS, however we are still missing a handful.

The **Information Verification Form** helps us to keep our contact information for student's families up to date, and allows us to be able to complete government forms, such as requests from Canada Revenue Agency, when they ask for confirmation of where a student lived and who they lived with. Without consistent, proper documentation, we are not able to complete such requests.

The **FOIPP** and **Information Technology Consents** are also important so that we know what permissions students have in regards to Media & Information release and computer/internet access on School computers. Computer Access will be revoked for students who have not submitted a completed Information Technology Form, and students who have not submitted the completed Consents for Information Disclosure will not be included in pictures.

Students will not be able to access Palliser technology without handing in the Information and Technology Consents form. They will not have access to Wifi at KAHS until it is submitted.


