Frequently Asked Questions



Q. What is Mr. Speaker's MLA for a Day?

The three-day program provides high school students with an awareness of the roles and responsibilities of an MLA, both as a legislator and a constituency representative.

Through workshops, personal interviews and debate in the Legislature Chamber, students will experience a diversity of viewpoints on provincial issues and gain an understanding of what it means to be an MLA.

Participants will also have the opportunity to have fun and connect with other young Albertans!

Q. What does it cost?

This program is free to participants and includes all meals, two nights' accommodation and travel expenses. Your arrival and departure details will be coordinated through the Visitor Services' office. Participants will be chaperoned for the duration of the program.

Q. Who can attend?

You are eligible to apply if you are currently a high school student enrolled in grades 10-12 in the province of Alberta. Home school students are also eligible to apply. We are able to accept 87 participants to the MLA for a Day program each year.
